

CR Band Parents' Association Meeting

Treasurer's Report: Kevin Ulrich discussed the budget. Kevin and Scott opened a \$5,000 - 36 month CD with 1st Bank of Wyoming at a rate of 1.2% that can go up as rates change. They moved \$10,000 to ING with a rate of 0.85% that can also increase as rates change. \$1,000 was taken from checking to be applied to the CD and was recorded in the "Actual" column of the Administration budget. Marion Malinowski motioned to accept the budget, John Moore seconded. The budget was accepted.

Ways and Means – Thanks to Rhonda Ringer for stepping up and taking over both Ways and Means and Band Cards.

Points – Marion Malinowski advised that point totals are on posted on the door. He is still waiting for point totals from pit and uniforms.

Car Wash - The car washes have been scheduled for April 16th and May 14th from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at Dover Pools on South State Street and Route 13. Volunteers will be needed and if anyone has sponges, buckets or hoses please bring them. Send the kids to work even if you can't be there.
