

CR Band Parents' Association Meeting
March 1, 2010 - Meeting was called to order at 7:33 p.m.

Secretary's Report: The minutes were distributed and read. Shelly Weber made a motion to accept and Kiel Hess seconded. The motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Kevin Ulrich discussed the budget. Kevin announced that the Board had decided to close the money market account with the First Bank of Wyoming and transfer the \$3,860 from that account along with \$11,140 from the checking to an account with ING Direct. There will still be approximately \$17,000 remaining in the checking account with First Bank of Wyoming. The ING account will earn interest at 1.1% whereas the Bank of Wyoming account is only earning .1%. It was discussed that it might be better in the long run to keep the account at a local bank versus a national bank. Kevin Ulrich and Scott Weber will ask the First Bank of Wyoming if they will match the ING rate in order to keep the money at the local bank. April Stover motioned to accept the budget, Joanne O'Connor seconded. The budget was accepted.

Ways and Means – Scott Weber advised that we earned \$118 from the Uno's fundraiser and a big thank you to Maryanne Grau for setting that up. Rhonda Ringer has volunteered to be nominated for chairperson of Ways and Means. If anybody would like to set up any other fundraisers such as Uno's, please feel free to make the calls and contact someone on the Board with the information and we will get the word out. Any help is greatly appreciated.

Points – Marion Malinowski advised that point totals are on the table in the back. He is still waiting for point totals from pit, uniforms, Gianni's and band cards.

Scrip – Scott Weber advised that we sold \$11,000 in Scrip cards and received \$186.00. It is a lot of work with little return, so it was decided that we will stop the Scrip program. Rhonda Ringer will take over Ways and Means and look for other more profitable fundraising programs.

Car Wash – Shirlene Jones advised that the car washes have been scheduled for April 16th and May 14th from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at Dover Pools on South State Street and Route 13. Volunteers will be needed. If anyone has sponges, buckets or hoses, please bring them.

Dover Downs – Marion Malinowski advised that the race is scheduled for May 14th and 15th and volunteers will be needed to work the race.

50/50 – Rhonda Ringer will be stepping down as chair and we need someone to take over that position.

Golf Tournament – April Stover advised that the golf tournament will be on June 3, 2011 at Wild Quail. The cost will be \$125 per golfer and includes 18 holes of golf, cart, a box lunch, a free beer, and a catered buffet dinner on the porch at the Wild Quail Country Club. Pepsi is donating soda and water and Budweiser is donating the beer. There will be a cash bar, and April is working with Wild Quail to get us a percentage of the bar sales. Sponsorship of holes will be \$200 or \$500, and Wild Quail will be doing all the signage for the sponsors at no extra cost. Deadline to sign up is May 20th. Please be sure to put the students name on the sign up sheet or sponsor sheet so points can be credited.

Chairpersons – We will need many chairpersons next year. We need someone for the website, membership and 50/50. Please let us know if you would like to volunteer. Any help is greatly appreciated.

Board Nominations – We need nominees for the Board positions for next year. We need a Vice-President and two Members at Large. Rhonda Ringer has volunteered for the Ways and Means position. Chaperones - Kevin Ulrich asked for volunteers to chaperone for next year. We need five chaperones and a nurse to travel with the students.
